Hadlow College, just on the Tonbridge side of Hadlow Village,
A26, Hadlow, near TONBRIDGE, Kent, TN11 0AL

How to find the College

Hadlow College is located on the A26, between Maidstone and Tonbridge. It is just outside Hadlow village in the direction of Tonbridge, West Kent. It is fairly easily accessible by road, rail and cycle.

BY CAR... The college has fairly easy road links via the A26, from the M20 (J4), M26 (J2a) or the A21 (Tonbridge South)

BY RAIL... Services from the Coast and London stop at Tonbridge www.nationalrail.co.uk, and the A7 bus runs at least hourly to Hadlow.

BY BUS... Arriva bus A7 goes from either Tonbridge or Maidstone – ask to stop at the main College site (NOT the animal unit). www.arrivabus.co.uk (search route info for Tonbridge to get the A7 timetable/map)

BY CYCLE... The college is accessible by routes from the surrounding area, but the normal care must be taken on the major and other roads. There are no public on-site cycle racks as such. www.sustrans.org

ON FOOT... During the day the college public areas can be accessed on foot from the A26.
