Recent Facility Improvements – The Parish Council arranged the new footpath and drainage works on Surrenden Playing Field and (in collaboration with the Youth Group) the new fencing and seating on the Youth Club land. The seating is for all to use and can be easily accessed from the High Street. Funding was secured from housing developers’ contributions held by Maidstone Borough Council for community facility improvements.

Dog Issues – Put bagged dog waste in any ordinary litter bin or domestic waste bins. Report fouling or persistent mess to MBC Environmental Services on 01622 602202. Report a stray or problem dog to MBC’s Dog Warden on 01622 602117.

Rubbish & Recycling Collections – Use black bins for rubbish. Use green recycling bins to dispose of paper, cardboard, glass bottles and jars, food and drink cartons, plastic bottles and food trays and containers. Leave bins and sacks at the boundary of your property by 7.00am on collection day and no earlier than the evening beforehand.
